

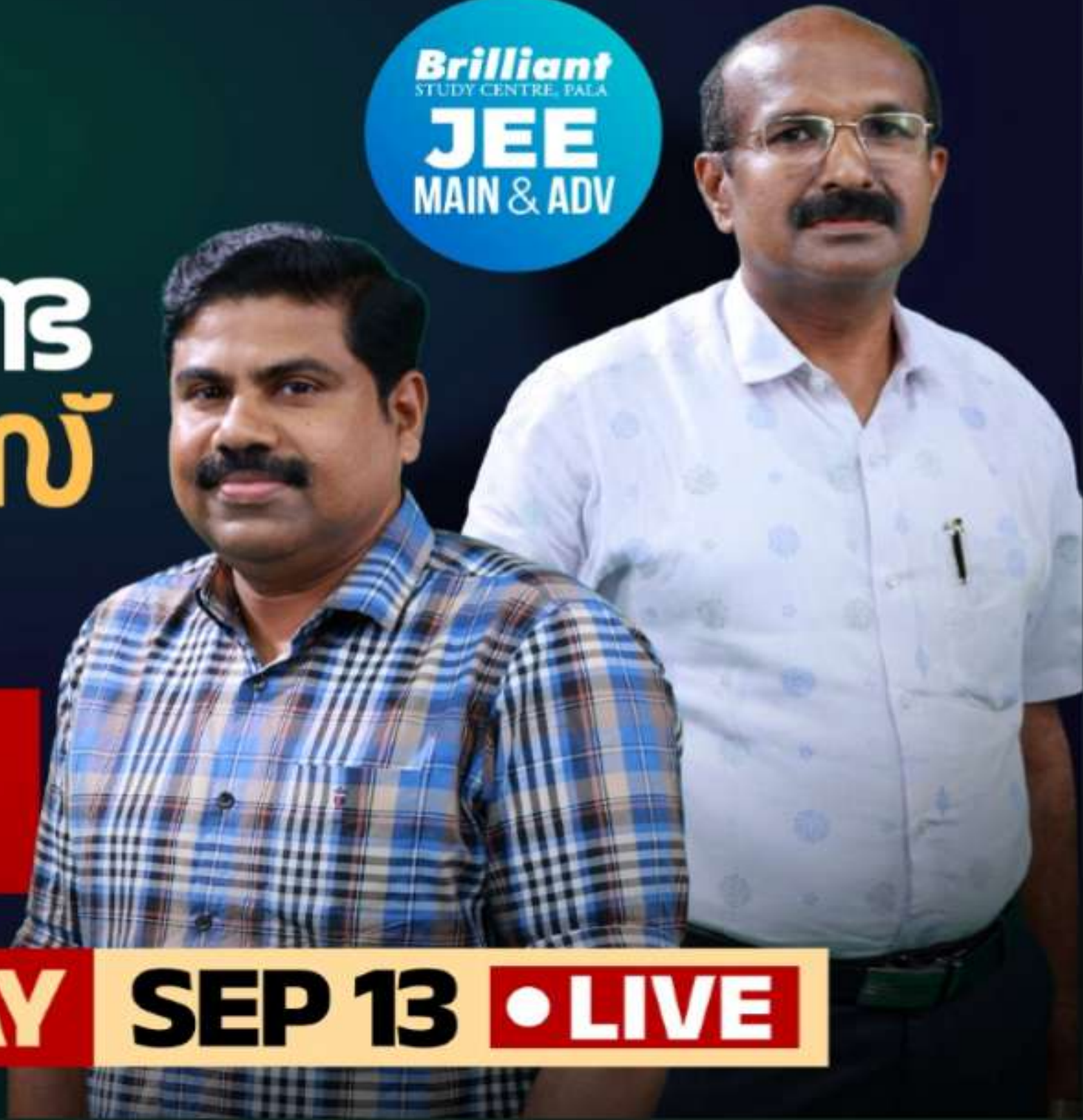

- Candidates should be among the top 2,50,000 successful candidates(including all categories) in B.E./B.Tech. paper (Paper I) of JEE Main
- A candidate can attempt JEE (Advanced) maximum of two times in two consecutive years.
- **Minimum Marks:** To be eligible for admission to an IIT, candidates must have passed their Class 12 (or equivalent) exam with a minimum of 75% aggregate marks (65% for SC, ST, and PwD candidates) or be in the top 20 percentile of their respective board.
